BLOOM'S REVISED TAXONOMY

Using the updated **Bloom Taxonomy**, we can create questions around the 6 levels, starting from the lowest level to the higher order thinking skill:

Creating General new ideas, products, or voice of viewing things		Designing, constructing, planning, producing, inventing.	Compose an engineering song, skit, and poem or rap to convey the story in a new form.
Evaluating Justifying a decision or course of action		Checking, hypothesising, critiquing, experimenting, judging	Assess whether or not you think this really happened.
Analysing Breaking information into parts to explore understandings and relationships)	Comparing, organising, deconstructing, interrogating, finding	Differentiate between how the child reacted and how you would react in each story event.
Applying Using information in anotation	ther	Implementing, carrying out, using, executing	Construct a theory as to why this was special for the child.
Understandi Explaining ideas or conc		Interpreting, summarising, paraphrasing, classifying, explaining	Summarize what the story was about.
Remembering Recalling Information	ng	Recognising, listing, describing, retrieving, naming, finding	Describe where this took place.
